Below you will find the rubrics for your final research paper. This paper has been broken into three parts. Each part has a separate due date, however, you will keep all the parts in the same document. The paper should be in 12pt Times New Roman and Double Spaced.

Part One - Due March 15th

In this section you will report on the state of homelessness in Savannah. You will analyze the data provided in class and use it to justify the need to house homeless families. You are required to identify what qualifies a house as a tiny house. Compare this to the square footage that is recommended for a traditional house that will be for a family of four. Using the parameters for tiny houses, propose a plan/layout for a tiny house that can accomodate a family of four in terms of square footage. Lastly, based on the size your research states a house for a family of 4 should be, research alternative forms of housing. Use these ideas to develop and idea of how you would like to construct a community of tiny houses designed for small families.
