Dear Raven Parents:

Students are beginning to work on their Science & Engineering projects. They often ask if they can work with others on the project. The following guidelines will lead to greater potential for success if your son or daughter would like to work with another STEM Academy student.

- The classmates must be in the same grade level.
- No more than two students may work together on a project.
- Parents of students must be willing and able to provide transportation to and from selected work locations.
- Parents of students must be willing to provide the necessary materials in an equitable fashion.
- Parents and students working together are expected to problem-solve issues rather than involving the teachers to mediate. Should such issues arise, the students involved will be expected to continue the project as individuals rather than as a group.
